



CT Electronics Limited **Limited Warranty**

CT Electronics Limited (“CTE”) warrants that our Vapor Chamber product (“Product”) is free from defects in materials and workmanship under normal use and proper storage, according to the following terms and conditions:

1. The limited warranty for the Product extends for the first Five (5) years beginning on the date of manufacturing. The date of manufacturing of a Product is set forth on the Product.
2. The limited warranty extends only to the original purchaser (“Customer”) of the Product and is not assignable or transferable to any subsequent purchaser/enduser without the approval of CTE.
3. During the limited warranty period, CTE or its authorized service network will repair or replace, at CTE’s option, any defective Product or parts thereof with new or factory rebuilt replacement items, and return the Product to the purchaser/enduser in working condition. No charge will be made to the purchaser/enduser for either parts or labor in repairing or replacing the Product. All returned parts shall become property of CTE.
4. Repaired Product will be warranted for the balance of the original warranty period or for ninety (90) days from the date of repair, whichever is longer.
5. All limited warranty for the Product extends only for the Product with proper original CTE identification marking/label intact on the Product. All accessories (including software, cable, optical disk, TIM, etc.) will not be covered in the warranty service.
6. Transportation, delivery and handling charges incurred in the transport of the Product to and from CTE or its authorized service center will be borne by the purchaser/enduser.
7. The purchaser/enduser shall have no coverage or benefits under this limited warranty if any of the following conditions are applicable:
 - a. The Product has been subject to: abnormal use, abnormal condition, improper storage, exposure to moisture or dampness, exposure to excessive temperature or other such environmental conditions, unauthorized modifications, unauthorized repair including but not limited to use of unauthorized spare parts in repairs, misuse, neglect, abuse, vandalism, accident, alteration, improper installation, Acts of God, spill of foods or liquids, maladjustment of purchaser/enduser controls or other acts which are beyond the reasonable control of CTE, unless caused directly by defects in materials or workmanship, and normal wear and tear of the Product.

- b. CTE was not notified by purchaser/enduser of the alleged defect or malfunction of the Product during the applicable limited warranty period.
 - c. The Product lot/serial number or the accessory date code from CTE marking/label has been removed, defaced or altered.
 - d. The Product was used with or connected to accessory not authorized by CTE, not fit for use with CTE's design or used in other than its intended use.
 - e. The Product shows evidence of tampering.
8. If a problem develops during the limited warranty period, the purchaser/enduser should take the following step-by-step procedure:
 - a. The purchaser/enduser shall return the Product to CTE for repair or replacement processing according to CTE Return Material Authorization (RMA) Policy.
 - b. The purchaser/enduser shall arrange for the Product to be delivered to the authorized service center. Expenses related to removing the Product from any installation are not covered under this limited warranty.
 - c. The purchaser/enduser will be billed for any parts or labor charges not covered by this limited warranty. The purchaser/enduser shall be responsible for expenses related to reinstallation of the Product.
 - d. If the Product is returned to CTE after the expiration of the warranty period, purchaser/enduser will be notified and will be charged accordingly if the purchaser/ enduser decides to proceed with the repair or replacement.
9. ANY IMPLIED WARRANTY OF MECHANABILITY, OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE OR USE, SHALL BE LIMITED TO THE DURATION OF THE FOREGOING WRITTEN WARRANTY. OTHERWISE, THE FOREGOING WARRANTY IS THE PURCHASER'S SOLE AND EXCLUSIVE REMEDY AND IS IN LIEU OF ALL OTHER WARRANTIES, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED. CTE SHALL NOT BE LIABLE FOR INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES OR A LOSS OF ANTICIPATED BENEFITS OR PROFITS, LOSS OR IMPAIRMENT OF PRIVACY OF CONVERSATIONS, WORK STOPPAGE OR LOSS OR IMPAIRMENT OF DATA ARISING OUT OF THE USE OR INABILITY TO USE THE PRODUCT.
10. The benefits conferred by this limited warranty are in addition to all other rights and remedies under any applicable mandatory legislation as may be in force from country (or area) to country (or area).
11. CTE neither assumes nor authorizes any authorized service center or any person or entity to assume for it any other obligation or liability beyond that which is expressly provided for in this limited warranty.
